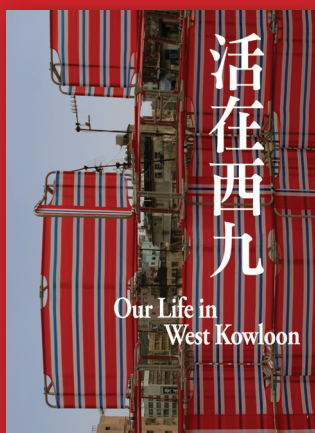


「活在西九」——舊區生活圖文集及 「一人生活」——精神病康復者圖文集

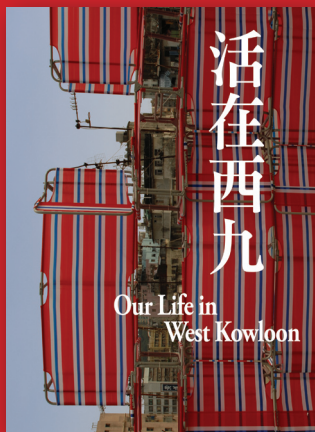
